## Spray-on Foam Insulation May Void Your Termite Protection Warranty

**A**s you know, termites in Georgia are a MAJOR problem, which potentially can cause millions of dollars in damage if left untreated and unmonitored. Because we value you as a customer, we feel it's important that you are aware of an issue that could affect your termite warranty.

A few of our clients and numerous other homeowners across Georgia have purchased a spray-on foam insulation treatment for their crawl spaces in an effort to conserve energy and prevent mold. While this is a very good energy-saving product, there are some serious issues that affect termite warranties as a result of the misapplication of this material.

Please know that the application of spray-on foam insulation could cover most or all wood in a crawl space so that continual inspection for termites is absolutely IMPOSSIBLE. In addition, if you can't visually inspect the wood and crawl space properly, you certainly can't treat termites that are concealed due to the foam. And continued termite inspections are essential in preventing termite damage and upholding termite warranties. We have seen some upscale homes like the one pictured here affected by this issue. If applied incorrectly, these insulation applications could seriously impair your home from receiving proper protection against termites.
